### **2017 Dennison Street Homicide**

On December 19, 2018, at approximately 2033 hours, the Little Rock Police Department responded to an assault with a weapon at 2017 Dennison Street. The caller reported the suspect assaulted his father, striking him with a brick. Upon officers arrival they made contact with Kendall Jones who was walking outside the residence. Officers then located the victim on the porch of the residence suffering from injuries to his head, which resulted in severe bleeding. The victim was transported by MEMS to UAMS Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. While on scene, officers met with the person who called police and developed Kendall Jones as a suspect. The deceased victim was identified as Joseph Jones Jr. (B/M DOB 10/08/1941).

Homicide Detectives and CSSU personnel responded to the scene. Mr. Kendall Jones was transported to the Detectives Division to be interviewed. Mr. Kendall Jones' vehicle was towed to the Little Rock Police Crime Scene Bay to be processed. The victims residence at 2024 Dennison was secured by officers and detectives, pending a search warrant.

The Pulaski County Coroners Office responded to UAMS, and transported Mr. Joseph Jones' body to the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory for an autopsy.

The next of kin of Mr. Joseph Jones was notified.

As a result of the investigation, Kendall Jones (B/M DOB 07/06/1978) was identified as a suspect in this incident. Mr. Jones was charged with 1st Degree Murder and transported to the Pulaski County Jail.
